

PROGRAM NOTES

This piece is a fun novelty number written in the style of a calypso, and is meant to be played in an energetic and light style. It was inspired by a little song that the composer used to sing to his younger children at bath time. Cleverly written and utilizing nautical and boat sounds throughout, many creative effects lend to light hearted fun. If you listen closely, you may hear sounds of boat traffic in the bay, pirate battles, submarines, sharks, and even superheroes saving the day. All in remembering children playing in the water and whistling a happy tune.

The music also features the happy-go lucky effect of whistling on the melody in be middle section. This can be very effective and add a lot. Some people are better at whistling than others. At your option, and for different colors, you may vary and/or mix that with some playing on the melody as noted in the score. Another option is to add a good midi whistling patch and have someone play that on keyboard to strengthen that effect if desired and/or mic a new whistling strongly on the melody. The ad lib trumpet solo at measure 49 is optional. Lic ening closely throughout, for good balance, will ensure that each line carries, is heard and contributes to the overall intent of the music.




